

Too Little Too Late

Immediate Release Tuesday 11 August 2009

Migration Alliance represents registered Migration Agents and welcomes the prosecution of an unregistered person for providing "immigration assistance".

The conviction of a person for the provision of immigration assistance is welcomed as is the custodial sentence.

The conduct of unregistered "agents" and the rise of education agents who also provide immigration assistance is a matter of grave concern. The vast majority of applications processed by DIAC are those submitted by education agents.

DIAC turns a blind eye to the provision of immigration assistance by education agents contrary to the criminal provisions of the Migration Act 1958.

Migration Alliance believes that the failure of DIAC to stop education agents from providing Immigration assistance is contrary to the Migration Act 1958 and is not in the national interest.

DIAC should stop providing advice, assistance, registration and access to education agents.

Migration Alliance believed that its members are both qualified and trained to provide the assistance required to persons seeking a visa for Australia.

Migration Alliance calls upon DIAC to enforce the law.
